




Give Bear a colorful disguise to help him find a book.










Matching Game

Connect the animal with the things they like. Bear has started the game for you. Bear likes books!



Add Bear's eyes, nose, and mouth. Add color and give your bear a name. Draw pictures of the things your bear likes.












Be Like Bear: Create a Book of Your Very Own

Fold Paper: Take eight sheets of paper and fold each one in half.





Stack Paper: Take the folded pages and stack them together.

Add a Cover: Take a piece of heavier paper (like construction paper) and fold it in half. This will be the cover of your book.





Add a Title: Write the title of your book and your name on the cover. Add a picture if you like!

Join the Pages: Ask an adult to help you keep the pages together by tying a piece of yarn or ribbon around the center fold of your book.





Create Your Story: Think about what you want your book to be about and then . . . Be like Bear and have fun creating a book of your very own!
